

Second International Research Seminar for Young Americanists:

The Second International Research Seminar for Young Americanists will take place at Centro Studi Americani, via Michelangelo Caetani 32 in Rome on October 14-15,2010 and is jointly organized by Centro Studi Americani and Centro Interuniversitario di Storia e Politica Euro-Americana (CISPEA).

Sixteen younger Americanists, from PhD candidates to recent assistant professors will give a 20-minutes presentation of the research they are conducting and will be commented by an established Americanist historian.

Applications in the history of American foreign relations, social history, the history of American political culture and institutions, American cultural and media history (but historical projects which fall outside these groups are acceptable too) are receivable by the Selection Committee, which will observe the following criteria. originality of the research project, wholeness of the 4-page and CV presentations, balance between Italian and non-Italian researchers, as well as regional and academic areas inside the country, balance between the different institutional positions

Each application should contain:

- a 4-page written presentation in English of the subject, sources, originality, state of advancement of the applicant's research project
- a 1-2-pages curriculum vitae of the applicant.

The deadline to receive the applications is July 9, 2010. Applications should be addressed to maurizio.vaudagna@lett.unipmn.it. Accepted summaries and curriculum will be placed on CISPEA's website (www.cispea.org) with the permission of the applicant.

Organizers will take financial responsibility for room and board expenses during the days of the seminar. Organizers will not be responsible for travel expenses. The conference takes place in English.
